Erasmus Exchange Program

Who can apply?

- UG: CGPA > 2,50
- UG students who are currently in their minimum 3rd or maximum 5th registration semester are eligible to apply

- **Important Note:**

You are **not** allowed to go to the Erasmus/Exchange if you haven't taken the courses in your Third-Year 1st Semester (i.e. MAN 321, MAN 335, MAN 341 & MAN 361) at Bilkent! It is your responsibility to have this condition!!!

In other words, you can go to the Erasmus/Exchange either in your **Third-Year 2nd Semester** or **Fourth-Year 1st Semester**. Please make your planning accordingly. There will be no exception!



Erasmus Exchange Program

Who can apply?

For the Graduate Students:

- Graduate: CGPA > 3,00
- Graduate students who have completed at least one semester at Bilkent University are eligible to apply
- BOTH **UG** and **Graduate** students must spend their final semester before graduation at Bilkent University



Erasmus Exchange Program

Course selection

Students will be able to transfer the credits for the courses that they have taken during their exchange period to their Bilkent curriculum. There are some restrictions.

- UG students have to take the following courses **at Bilkent University**:
 - MAN 213 Principles of Financial Accounting
 - MAN 321 Corporate Finance
 - MAN 335 Fundamentals of Marketing
 - MAN 341 Production Management
 - MAN 361 Organization Theory

- Graduate students must consult their advisors

- ✦ FBA has exchange agreements with universities in Europe, the Americas, Asia, and Australia.
- ✦ FBA students are eligible to apply for an Erasmus exchange period to be spend at our Erasmus+ Partners.

- ✦ Our international partners have been carefully selected and are institutions with high quality education and research programs.



Erasmus Exchange Program

- Paying the regular Bilkent tuition or having a scholarship covers the tuition abroad, but students are responsible for:
 - Travel
 - Accommodation
 - Living expenses
 - Visa
 - Health Insurance
 - Residence Permit
- Mobility grant covers **part** of the expenses
- The students **THEMSELVES** are responsible for their application procedure to the host institution, visa, accommodation and residence permit applications;

- Application deadline: will be announced!
- The applications should be submitted online through our web based program:
<http://app.erasmus.bilkent.edu.tr/>
- All applications should be done online:
 - Your CV
 - Statement of purpose including **proposed course selections** at your university choices

Please note that you have to determine five university choices while you are making your application. Hence do your research accordingly!

- For the Graduate students:

- All applications should be done online:
 - Your CV
 - Statement of purpose including **proposed course selections** at your university choices.

Please note that you have to determine **five** university choices while you are making your application. Hence do your research accordingly!

- Graduate students additionally need to upload an approval letter from their thesis advisors for their participation to the Erasmus+ Program!!!

- **For MS programs:** You should find a thesis advisor at the partner university- before going!



Erasmus Exchange Program

- We are using a program which can access the students database and calculate the students ranking.
- The ranking criteria:
 - CGPA 50%
 - Language proficiency 50%
 - 25% Eng 101
 - 25% Eng 102
- After placement and nominations, the more complex application procedure to the partner institutions starts!!!!
- Erasmus documentation:
 - Learning Agreement (WORD)
 - Pre Approval Form (WORD)
 - Official Dates Form (WORD)



Erasmus Exchange Program

- Qualified students' CGPAs will be checked by the Office of International Students and Exchange Programs at the end of **Spring 2023** for **Fall 2023 outgoings** and at the end of **Fall 2023** for **Spring 2024 outgoings** to make sure that they are still qualified to participate in the program
- **Important Notes:**
 - ECTS stands for *European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System* and is the standard credit system across the European Union
 - You are required to take courses worth of at least **30 ECTS** (at the partner university) = **25 ECTS** (5 Courses at Bilkent- 15 Bilkent credits)
 - ✓ In order to transfer a course, you **SHOULD** get the **grade to graduate** in the partner university!!!



Erasmus Exchange Program

o **Important Notes:**

- Fill out your “Pre-Approval Form” & “Learning Agreement”
- Approval process will be **ONLINE**- You should get your approval from your Academic Erasmus/Exchange Coordinator (Ceren Aydogmus, Tolga Baycan)
- Don't wait until last day for the preparations: Draft pre-approval form & the course syllabuses at the partner university.
- If you need to change a course after you arrive at host institution:
 - Ask for approval of your Exchange Coordinator via email.
 - Fill out the “During Mobility” part of your Learning Agreement
- Consult Ms. Elif Ünsal from OISEP @ Registrars Office for all other documentation

Erasmus Exchange Program

- If you are planning to go to a university where the language of instruction is different than English and you want to take courses in their native language, you will also need to submit an official certificate proving your proficiency level in that language.
- The minimum level should be B2. For those who do not have a certificate proving their proficiency, an exam will be held in German, French, Italian, and Spanish.
- Exam dates & times will be announced on the web page of Bilkent University / Exchange Programs.

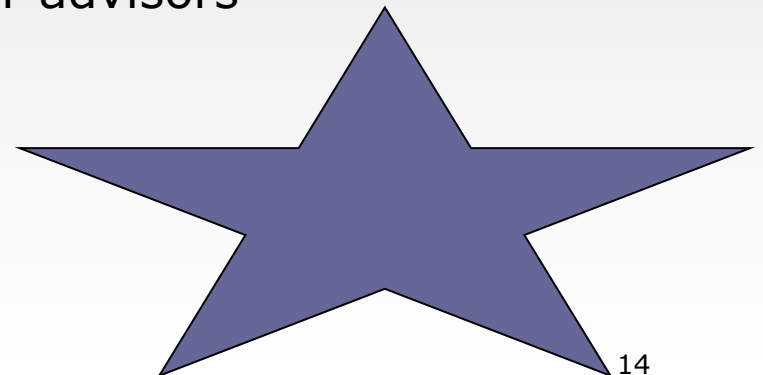


Erasmus Exchange Program
