

1) When can you do the summer practice?

Between the last day of spring semester to the first day of fall semester.

2) How long should the summer practice last?

20 consecutive working days (national holidays on business days do not count)

3) Who is eligible to do the summer practice?

There are two conditions that must be satisfied:

- a) Successfully pass both MAN 213 and MAN 262
- b) In addition to the item a), successfully pass 2 out of the 4 following courses: MAN 321, MAN 341, MAN 335, MAN 361

4) Does the University find us a place to have our summer practice?

No, students are expected to arrange companies for their summer practice on their own.

5) Where can I have my summer practice?

There are not many restrictions on this selection and the approval is made on a case by case basis. However, it is required that the workplace should have at least 10 full-time employees. For a better explanation, see the next question.

6) Is the company that I want to have my summer practice approved?

Following your submission of “Company Description and Approval Form” to the faculty, it is your responsibility to check (in 2 business days) whether the Faculty approved your company or not. You can check this status by contacting our associate dean Prof. Zeynep Önder. Otherwise, faculty will not get back to you about this situation.

7) What is the deadline of submitting the “Summer Practice Acceptance Form”?

Once the company approves that you will spend your summer practice there and signs the related summer practice acceptance form, you must bring this signed document to the Faculty on the earliest of the following two dates:

- a) At least two weeks before the summer practice starts
- b) No later than July 15

For example, if your summer practice starts on July 1st, then the deadline for delivering this document to the faculty is June 15th (two weeks earlier). If your summer practice starts on August 15th, then the deadline for this delivery is July 15th.

8) Any more advice?

Don't wait for deadlines to do the necessary.
